Juandalynn R. Abernathy is the daughter of Rev. Dr. Ralph Abernathy and one of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s goddaughters. She was a witness to the Freedom March on Washington. In her career as a professional opera singer and choir director, she has used her passion for music as a pathway to education about social responsibility and fostering community.
