Bucks County high school boys basketball roundup: Dec. 7

Eric Dixon scored 29 points to lead the Abington High School boys basketball team to 58-51 win against Gonzaga, as the Ghosts travelled to Washington D.C. to kick off the 30th Annual Gonzaga D.C. Classic on Friday. Lucas Monroe chipped in with 16 points to ensure the win for the visitors. Abington will play Episcopal of Texas in the semifinal round on Saturday.

New Hope-Solebury 49, Upper Merion 36: Connor Wallace scored 19 points to lead the Lions to an opening day win in the Golden Bears Tip-Off Classic. Topher Taylor earned a double-double, scoring 13 points and grabbing 13 rebounds, as well as three blocks.

Archbishop Wood 54, Episcopal Academy 41: Daeshon Shepherd scored eight of his 18 points in the fourth quarter to seal the Vikings' win in the first round of the Triangle Club Tip-off Tournament. Julius Phillips had 13 points and Jaylen Stinsen added 11 in the victory.

Holy Ghost Prep 44, Beechcroft 42: Sean Morrison scored 12 points to give the Firebirds the edge in the closely-contested Bethel Park Tip-Off Tournament. Greg Sylvester had nine points and Tyler Mish added six as the Firebirds held off Beechcroft, the reigning city champions from Columbus, Ohio.

Saye Area 57, Morrisville 33: Tahmeer Glover scored 18 points, but the Bulldogs were bested in the opening round of the Bristol Tip-Off Tournament.

Central Bucks East 62, Boyertown 39: Nick Roggio scored 16 points and tallied 16 rebounds as the Patriots stormed out to a 36-13 halftime lead and never looked back. Joe Jackman had 14 points and Leo Masterson added 12 points, four assists and four steals as the Patriots opened the season with a decisive win.

George School 56, Valley Forge Military 46: Onias Outlaw scored 10 points in the second half, as the Cougars put up 39 points after halftime to earn the comeback win. Charlie Trey-Masters paced the offense with 15 points — all three-pointers — while Kenneth Rodriguez grabbed nine rebounds and added ten points.

Plumstead Christian 75, Valley Forge Baptist 54: Drew Grow scored 24 points, and Carson Curry tallied 23, as the Panthers dominated in their season opener. Grow connected on a trio of three-pointers and Matt Bortolotti scored 12 points in the victory.

Liberty 55, Quakertown 47: Bobby Rosenburger put up 22 points for the Panthers, who scored 18 points in the fourth quarter. The Panthers' staged an impressive comeback attempt in the second half, outscoring Liberty 28-21 in an attempt to erase a 15-point halftime deficit. Elias Ortiz scored nine points and Sean Harrison had seven in the loss.
