School and Community:

Founded in 1893, George School is a
 Quaker, college preparatory, coed boarding
 and day school for students in grades 9
 through 12. George School is accredited by
 the Pennsylvania Association of Independent
 Schools and Middle States Association of
 Colleges and Schools. The International
 Baccalaureate program is accredited by The
 International Baccalaureate. George School
 is one of the few boarding schools in the
 United States offering the IB Diploma.

Prior to 2020-2021, our school
 year consisted of three trimesters
 of 11 weeks each. Beginning in
 2020-2021, our school year consists
 of two semesters of 17 weeks each.
 Midterm grades for seniors will be
 reported in late November, first
 semester grades in late January, and final
 grades in mid-June. Transcripts report
 trimester/semester letter grades for term
 classes and year-end cumulative letter
 grades for year-long classes. **George
 School does not weight grades,
 compute class rank, or report GPA.**

George School offers college-prep,
 advanced, intensive, Advanced
 Placement (AP), and International
 Baccalaureate (IB) courses.

In representing to colleges the rigor
 of our students' academic programs,
 George School designates each
 student's program as **demanding,
 more demanding, highly
 demanding, or most demanding.**

COVID-19 RESPONSE

Term 3 of the 2019-2020 school
 year was entirely remote. Nearly all
 classes issued cumulative year-long
 letter grades. During the 2020-2021
 school year, students had the option of
 attending George School as boarding,
 on-campus day, or remote learners,
 and instruction was both in-person
 and virtual. Students received letter
 grades as normal. We anticipate a
 return to fully in-person instruction
 for the 2021-2022 school year.

George School requires its students
 to respond truthfully when college
 applications ask about disciplinary
 violations. Counselors will likewise
 respond truthfully about student
 disciplinary violations when asked.
