



SUMMER ENGLISH IMMERSION PROGRAM Rising 7th to 9th grade students

Deorge School offers a three-week Summer English Immersion program designed to equip international students with the English they need to succeed at US high schools. Based on more than 50 years of experience in educating students from around the world, the program is designed for rising seventh- to ninthgrade students, approximately ages 12 to 14.



The program is academically oriented, covering content such as literature, history, and science to prepare students for the English demands of different disciplines. While acquiring language proficiency, they build their critical reading, writing, and oral presentation skills.

Students also get a real taste of what it's like to attend a top US boarding school. They enjoy the 240-acre wooded campus as well as recreational activities like arts, kayaking, swimming, and team sports. They take excursions around the Northeast—to New York City, historic Philadelphia, theme parks, and nearby competitive colleges, including Princeton, the University of Pennsylvania, and NYU.
