

## NAMING GEORGE SCHOOL IN YOUR WILL OR TRUST

Naming George School in your will or trust is a meaningful way to imagine your legacy. The simplest form of gift planning—a bequest is a donor's "ultimate gift", the largest gift he or she is capable of. A bequest costs you nothing during your lifetime yet provides valuable support to George School.

Your gift may be a specific dollar amount, a percentage of your estate or the remainder after all other provisions are specified. Below is suggested language to take to your attorney for use in drafting your bequest.
